What Is Our Platform?

Each month, a specific theme will be given. Entries must be **relevant to the assigned theme**.

5. Submission Deadline Must Be Respected

Late submissions will **not be accepted** under any circumstances.

6. Language & Decency

Content must be:

- Respectful
- o Non-political
- o Non-religious (unless educational)
- o Free from hate, abuse, or disrespect

7. Proper Credit Must Be Given

Student names, class, school name, and teacher mentor details must be clearly mentioned.

8. No Commercial Advertisements

Newspapers must not contain paid promotions, brand advertisements, or sponsorship logos.

9. One Entry Per School (Per Category)

Each school may submit **only one newspaper per month per category**, unless otherwise announced.

10. Judges' Decision Will Be Final

All results, selections, and awards decided by the judging panel will be **final and binding**.

11. Right to Publish Reserved

The platform holds the right to **publish**, **promote**, **and showcase** submitted content with proper credit.

12. Misconduct Will Lead to Disqualification

Any form of cheating, plagiarism, fake information, or misconduct will result in **immediate disqualification**.

13. Data Safety & Privacy

Student data will be used **only for official purposes** and will never be shared publicly without consent.
